Our Seventh Grade students prepare and practice for their *Bar* or *Bat Mitzvah*, as well as learn what it means to be a good Jewish individual in today's world and why it is important to continue to learn about being Jewish. *Mitzvah* Projects are very important, both in and out of the Synagogue; leading services on both Friday Nights and *Shabbat* Mornings is greatly encouraged. Each TBT *Bar* and *Bat Mitzvah* student makes their own *Yad*: their personal Torah pointer for the ceremony. Cooking demonstrations, arts and crafts projects and in-depth discussion groups round out the Seventh Grade curriculum at TBT.

## **B'DARKEINU**

B'darkeinu is a special, 2-year program for children in 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades, who want the knowledge of what it means to be Jewish but did not go through a traditional, 5-year program. It culminates with a *Bar* or *Bat Mitzvah* ceremony on a *Shabbat* afternoon, once they have completed our 2-year program. It is a wonderful way to instill Judaism and give those with less time to prepare a true understanding of what being Jewish is all about.
